



Speedwatch in Lacey Green and Loosley Row

Request for Volunteers

You will have noticed the black box moving around Lacey Green and Loosley Row telling drivers to keep to the speed limit. This mobile vehicle activated sign (MVAS) is owned by the Parish Council for use in Lacey Green, Loosley Row and Speen. There are five locations in Lacey Green, one in Loosley Row and two in Speen. When it is in Speen, the Speedwatch co-ordinator will move it around Speen.

We are looking for volunteers to form a Speedwatch group to move it around Lacey Green and Loosley Row and to liaise with the Speen Speedwatch group in sharing the use of the equipment.

A timetable is being worked out for the movement of the MVAS and it is very straightforward to move. The battery will last approximately 3 weeks and is quick to charge up.
